<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read different traditional fairy tales and have a go at writing your own. Make some puppets to help re-tell your story. Have a look at The 3 Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig and The True Story of the 3 Little Pigs.</li><li>• Read Where the Wild Things Are-make your own wild thing, make a boat and go on your own adventure around the world/into space/under the sea. Investigate whether your boat will float or sink. Make a map &amp; record where you go and what you see. Be as creative as you can! Can you grow your own wild thing plants?</li><li>• Practise your reading &amp; word tub-learn new words and start noting punctuation such as exclamation marks and question marks.</li><li>• Find rhyming words and write your own rhymes/poems. You could use all our spelling quiz patterns learnt so far and then explore some new ones eg ee, oo, or, ir, oa, ea, ow, oi/oy</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Keep practising your Big Maths as discussed on Parent's Evening</li><li>• Practise using money-finding totals up to 10p, 20p and £1.</li><li>• Then learn how to give change from 10p, 20p 30p etc</li><li>• Keep practising the time-analogue and digital(if you're feeling brave)</li><li>• Learn how to read temperature on a thermometer</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practise your handwriting, full stops and capital letters, question marks and exclamation marks. Try to include adjectives, alliteration and similes in your writing</li> </ul>
