




### **Macmillan Coffee Morning**

#### Nasal Flu vaccine

The School Nursing Immunisation Team will visit school on **08/11/2024** to offer children a nasal spray flu vaccine. The NHS recommends that your child has a flu vaccination every year. Please complete the consent form as soon as possible and no later than 72 hours before the day of the session.


