Y1 Embark on an Incredible Dinosaur Adventure

Y5 visit Chapter Arts

Last week our Year 5 pupils had a fantastic day exploring two exhibitions at Chapter Arts: Ntiense Eno-Amooquaye's *Crashing the Glass Slippers* - a diverse body of work encompassing photography, performance, drawing, fashion, and textiles - and Jade De Montserrat's *Backgrounding Foregrounding*, featuring vibrant marigolds blooming across the entrance of Chapter Arts. The pupils had the opportunity to investigate how both artists drew upon their 'cynefin' and inspirations to shape their artwork. Inspired by what they learned, our children then worked on creating and refining their own symbols (a key aspect of both artists), planning how these will be incorporated into their own artwork back at school. A special thank you goes to Chapter Arts for organising such a wonderfully inspiring day - it was truly unforgettable!



PE Uniform

The wearing of school uniform during the first few weeks of this half term have been excellent. However, there have been a number of occasions where children have been wearing inappropriate or unsafe clothing for PE. On safety grounds, this may result in your child not being able to participate in the lesson.

Earrings in particular are dangerous during PE sessions. Studs or sleepers are permitted but for obvious safety reasons, rings, hoops or dangling earrings are not. All long hair should also be tied up during PE sessions.

As you are aware the PE uniform consists of either black shorts / black skort, black joggers / black leggings and a house colour t-shirt. A long sleeve red overtop is also an additional option. This uniform is available via A Class Apart but purchasing from A Class Apart is not compulsory as the items mentioned can also be purchased from a variety of other shops and supermarkets.
