## **Safer Internet Day 2025**

On Tuesday, the whole school took part in Safer Internet Day 2025, exploring this year's theme: *'Too good to be true? Protecting yourself and others from scams online.'* The day began with a fantastic whole-school assembly led by our Digital Leaders, who introduced the theme and encouraged everyone to think about online safety. Throughout the day, pupils engaged in interactive lessons, role-playing scenarios, and creative projects to help them spot online scams, identify misleading information, and stay safe in the digital world. It has been a valuable experience for all, helping our pupils become more confident and responsible internet users!



## **Y4 visit Bristol Aquarium!**

On Thursday, our Year 4 class had an unforgettable visit to Bristol Aquarium, where they took part in the Save Our Seas workshop. This guided tour gave the children a chance to observe a variety of fascinating marine creatures up close while learning about the importance of protecting our oceans. They explored different marine environments, including mangrove forests, rainforests, and the open ocean, and discussed the impact of human activity on these delicate ecosystems. A highlight of the visit was the exclusive fish feeding experience, where pupils got to see marine life in action! The children also took part in a workshop on Coral Reefs and Climate Change, deepening their understanding of conservation efforts to protect these vital habitats. It was a fantastic day filled with discovery, curiosity, and a renewed appreciation for our oceans!



## **Y6 visit Cardiff Museum**

Our Year 6 pupils had an exciting and educational trip to Cardiff Museum, where they took part in a Climate Change LEGO workshop. Using LEGO, the children designed and built their own ecosystems while exploring creative solutions to help protect the environment. This hands-on activity encouraged teamwork, problem-solving, and a deeper understanding of climate change and sustainability. After the workshop, the children had the opportunity to explore the museum's Natural History section, where they discovered fascinating exhibits on wildlife, fossils, and prehistoric creatures. It was a fantastic day of learning, creativity, and discovery!
