Reception to Year 3 had a fantastic time at the *Science Made Simple* workshop, where they explored different modes of transport and the forces that make them move. Year 3 and Year 6 also got creative working with Maisie on a special baking session that combined science and delicious treats. A huge thank you to Dow Silicones, who taught the children about the pH levels in sugary sweets, helping them understand the science behind their favourite treats.
