<u>Important Notice: Early School Closure – Friday 23rd May at 1pm</u>

Following on from the letter shared earlier this week, we would like to remind families that **school will close early at 1pm on Friday 23rd May** to allow staff to take part in essential training.

As part of a local authority-wide improvement programme, our school is transitioning to a new Management Information System called Arbor, which will replace SIMS. Arbor will allow us to communicate more effectively with families, manage payments, monitor attendance and behaviour, and share updates on your child's progress — all through one easy-to-use app.

To ensure a smooth and secure transition, staff need to complete vital training and system setup. This is a large-scale change, and like many other schools across the Vale of Glamorgan who have already undertaken this process, we will be closing for half a day to ensure everything is in place.

Pupils will still receive their lunch as normal before being collected at 1pm.

We appreciate your understanding and support as we make this transition. Further information about how to download and use the Arbor app will be shared with all parents and carers in due course.
