Have Your Say: Changes to School Food Regulations

Big Fresh Catering Company would like to make parents and carers aware of an important Welsh Government consultation on proposed changes to the Healthy Eating in Schools (Nutritional Standards and Requirements) Regulations.

As the school's meal provider, Big Fresh has already begun introducing some changes in line with the proposed updates. These include a greater focus on nutritious, hot, home-cooked meals, as well as the removal of bread as a daily option and other adjustments aimed at improving the overall quality of school food. Their aim is to support the health and wellbeing of all pupils through better nutrition and balanced meals.

It's important that all stakeholders – including parents, carers, and pupils – have the opportunity to contribute to this process. There is also a child-friendly version of the consultation, and Big Fresh encourages children to share their views too.

Year 5 Summer essentials - (Examples: garden toys; bubbles; water balloons; water guns; sun cream; ice lolly making kit; fun items – stick on tattoos/face paints; sporting goods)
