Our work this term will include...

- Mathematics & Numeracy – Colours-pink and black (summer 1) and light and dark blue (summer 2). Shapes-exploring 2D and 3D shapes. Sorting/matching. Counting. Number. Capacity. Pattern. Time, money.
- Languages, Literacy & Communication – listening to stories about animals and mini beasts. Recognising and writing names. Tracing. Nursery rhymes. Sound recognition. Welsh greetings, counting, singing, weather, colours and feelings.
- Humanities – learning about other cultures, endangered species and sustainability
- Health & Wellbeing – developing fine and gross motor skills using low and medium level apparatus, climbing and balancing, developing coordination, strength and spatial awareness. Taking part in Sports day. Developing friendships and relationships, Learning to care for animals.
- Science & Technology – exploring the season of summer, caring for animals, observing, asking questions and learning about animals and mini beast
- Expressive Arts – exploring movements to create a series of body shapes and pathways using the animals and mini beasts as a topic. Singing songs and rhymes about animals and mini beasts and creating music accompanied by percussion instruments. Different animal patterns, , designing and constructing models, printmaking,
- RE – Begin to identify important of Christian festivals. Begin to find different ways to celebrate God's gifts to u Begin to understand that the school belongs to the church Understanding that a church is a special place of worship. Listen to a range of prayers and begin to learn to identify how to start and end a prayer. To experience awe and wonder when entering a church, school hall, other meeting place etc Begin to take responsibility, share and cooperate with others Attend worship times to prepare for Reception.



How you can help your child at home...

- Label all their belongings
- Enjoy reading stories together and discussing their contents
- Discuss, label and share feelings and emotions
- Encourage your child to hold a pencil correctly, when they show signs of being ready. Use sheet provided.
- Correct Letter and number formation-sheets to be provided.
- Provide mark making opportunities
- Play number and counting games together.
- Talk about the sounds that letters make.
- Encourage independence in personal care: putting coat on, carrying belongings etc
- Enjoy puzzles and jigsaws
- Practise under/overwriting their name or ordering the letters
- Sing Nursery rhymes and action songs together and take part in our rhyme challenge
- Enjoy messy play and exploring sensory experiences
- Provide opportunities to develop their fine motor skills with resources like lego, playdough
- Exploring the great outdoors
- Provide opportunities to develop their gross motor skills.

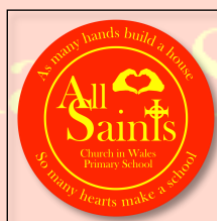
