Our work this term will include...

- Mathematics & Numeracy – Addition, subtraction, rotating shapes, compose shapes, decompose shapes, sharing, grouping, even and odd numbers, doubling, patterns, describe positioning, explore mapping, representing maps, creating maps.
- Languages, Literacy & Communication – CVC words, creative writing, instructional writing, rhyming, basic punctuation.
- Humanities – History of sports, holidays in the past, seas and oceans, coral reefs, maps.
- Health & Wellbeing – Teamwork, the human body, keeping healthy, keeping fit, sporting heroes, keeping safe at sea.
- Science & Technology – Forces, shadows, the ocean, floating experiments.
- Expressive Arts – Rhymes, logos, designing, seaside songs, seaside art.
- RE – Special books, The Bible, Major stories from the Old and New Testament, Symbols.

How you can help your child at home...



- Support your child with their handwriting but allow them to write independently.
- Support them in learning to write their name with correct pencil grip using capital and lowercase letters.
- Play number games, write and read numbers and letters in different medium e.g., shaving foam, sand, glitter, playdough, chalk.
- Read stories together and encourage them to talk about them. (e.g., How do you think the character felt? What part did you enjoy the most and why?)
- Talk to them about: Spring and the changes in season.
- Talk about or provide experiences relating to our topic (Move It & On the Beach!)
- Try to provide your child with opportunities to speak to you in Welsh. E.g., Counting to 10, different colours, naming body parts, can I (Ga i...), What do you want? (Beth wyt ti eisiau?), saying thank you and no thank you.)
- Talk to them about healthy eating and have them become involved with their meal. You can try cooking activities linked to special times in the church calendar or try traditional Welsh recipes e.g., Welsh cakes or healthy options of a favourite recipe.
