Our work this term will include...

<u>Mathematics & Numeracy</u> – Addition and subtraction. Doubles and near doubles. Comparing length and mass of objects. Money – recognising and counting coins. Multiplication and division - counting in 2s,10s and 5s, making equal groups and sharing. Counting forwards and backwards to 100. Sorting using a Carol Diagram.

Languages, Literacy & Communication – Initial blends tr/fr/pr/dr/sm etc. End sounds ck/ff/ng/xt/ll. Oo,ee, vowels and magic e. Write simple stories using emergent writing, beginning to use full stops and exclamation marks. Letter formation, emphasis on correct formation and orientation lower case and capitals. Writing full name. Begin to spell a wide range of key words consistently and correctly. Welsh – where I live, pets, the weather.

<u>Humanities</u> – the stories of Grace Darling, Jeane Baret and Mathew Hensen. Using Timelines and discovering when different transport was invented. Learn about RNLI. Learn how disabled people use public transport. World Earth Day and World Oceans Day

<u>Health & Wellbeing</u> – P.E. – athletics and games. Jigsaw. Action for Happiness – Exercise and Trying out. How to keep safe using different modes of transport. Beach Safety.

<u>Science & Technology</u> – Learning about different types of transport, floating and sinking, electric and driverless cars and the environment. Making submarines and boats.

*Expressive Arts-* linking music to emotions, explore sounds in the environment and use technology to create a sound collage. Looking at paintings of stormy seas – creating their own using watercolours and technology.

<u>**RVE</u>** –Understanding Christianity – The Gospel -What is the good news that Jesus brings? Visit to All Saints Church.</u>
