We are learning through the topic Minibeasts. Our work this term will include...

- Mathematics & Numeracy: Fractions, money, time properties of 2D and 3D shapes, sorting and classifying shapes, regular and irregular hexagons and pentagon, vertices. Temperature, mass and capacity.
- Language, Literacy and Communication- Reading key words, developing reading fluency and expression, continuing with alphabetical ordering, developing reading comprehension skills. Spelling and phonics: long vowel sounds: ow (bow) ow (owl) igh (light) ie (pie) and double letters. Writing: using a wider range of connectives (i.e. suddenly, then, after a while, in a flash) and time connectives (i.e. finally next, after that, meanwhile), using describing words, alliteration, similes in writing. Writing posters and invitations, creative stories. Putting full stops in the writing with greater independence. Using ? in writing. Handwriting: correct letter formation, ensuring all tall letter are clearly taller including capitals. Speaking skills: Presenting a Minibeast presentation to the class and answering questions based upon it.
- Cymraeg: likes and dislikes (Dw i'n hoffi /Dw i ddim yn hoffi) with regards to food and hobbies, dillad (clothes) and anifeiliaid (animals).
- Spanish: counting to ten, colours and simple greetings.
- Humanities World Ocean's Day (8th June)- plastic pollution, reduce, reuse, recycle and protecting sea creatures. Local habitats. Countries of the world and exploring Google Earth.
- Health & Wellbeing- Activities based around Action for Happiness: Acceptance: Be comfortable with who you are and Meaning: Be part of something bigger. Jigsaw activities: Relationships (keeping safe, trust, celebrating my special relationships) and Changing me (life cycles, growing, changing me, looking ahead). PE: Ball skills, different ways of handling and passing a ball. athletics throwing, running and jumping skills. Team games.
- Science & Technology: Minibeasts and living things habitats and life cycles, sorting and classifying living things. The impact of the environment on living things. Design and make a bug hotel. Making own branch diagram in Jit on Hwb.
- Expressive Arts: Music: Creating a sound scape to a story; high, middle low music composition and performance. Minibeast music composition. Art: Various media to create images and models based on Minibeasts. Artist Henri Rousseau: Tiger in a Tropical Storm painting. Digital Media: Hwb Jit Animation Jit Draw. Dance: Different actions and movements linked to Minibeasts. Creating own simple sequences. Creating and evaluating a Sut with ti? dance. Making and animal themed animation.
- RVE (Religion, Values an Ethics) : Understanding Christianity The parable of the lost son/ Jonah and the Whale. Appreciating creation, responsibility and caring for nature. Judaism and Jewish traditions. Understanding Christianity Being thankful, friendship and forgiveness. The story of Zacchaeus. Appreciating creation, responsibility and caring for nature. Our school values this term are Trust & Thankfulness.

How you can help your child at home...


- Practice the weekly spellings posted on Doodle Spell.
- Practice spelling the key words from the sheet given out last term, please ask for a new sheet if needed.
- Please undertake lots and lots of reading at home. Read books to your child, reading together their reading scheme books and other books. A bedtime story is still a very important part of your child's development in Year 2. We have the 'Donut Stop Reading' certificates at school for your child to achieve and earn house points!
- Lots of practice of the words in the word tub (if relevant). Thank you.
- Doodle Maths and Doodle Spell often during the week in small bursts. There is also Doodle Language to explore.
- Explore JIT on Hwb, familiarise with the programs on there. Please let me know if your child has saved some work on Jit as I am able to access it and can discuss it with them. We will also be focusing on Jit this term in school.
- Look up facts about minibeasts, animas, nature, the ocean and other environments. Bring pictures, books, writing and drawings into school to show and talk about
- Download the Pic Collage app and use it to create collages and posters.
