### **Our work this term will include...**

**Mathematics & Numeracy** – Multiplication, division, times table (3,4,8 and 10), temperature, time, money, fractions and algebra.

**Languages, Literacy & Communication** – Instructional writing, research, factfiles, narrative writing, phonics, doodle learning, Welsh lessons around the body and the weekend.

**Humanities** – Looking at the food we eat and from other cultures, understanding where food comes from and the implication of groups, such as, fair trade.

**Health & Wellbeing** – keys to happiness, physical education, teamwork, learning about the importance of a balanced diet, the importance of good hygiene when handling food and UNCR.

**Science & Technology** – Testing the effect of exercise on pulse rate, how food moves through the body, the roles of different organs, looking at the difference between unhealthy and healthy foods, research, doodle learning, creating digital pieces of work, continuing to access hwb, Jit and seesaw.

**Expressive Arts** – P Buzz, Cooking and opportunities to work with food, creating and singing songs for St. David's Day, St David's Day art, spring paintings, creating art using a range of resources, tools and materials, developing their creativity by giving them opportunities to paint, colour, build and draw, linked to the topics and key dates.

**RE** – Special places to us, Christians and in Islam and understand the significance of pilgrimage.

### How you can help your child at home...

- Supporting them with their reading and word tubs.
- Reading with them as often as possible to support them and ask questions to develop their comprehension skills.

- Any recycling would be very handy for our junk modelling.

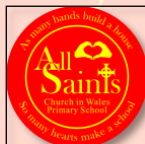
