Our work this term will include...

Mathematics & Numeracy – Fractions, money, pictograms, bar graphs, statistics.

Languages, Literacy & Communication – Explanation writing, research, factfiles, newspaper writing, phonics, doodle learning, Welsh lessons around the clothes and places we go.

Humanities – Looking at the history of the Titanic, location and names of different oceans and different sea creatures we find there.

Health & Wellbeing – Water safety, keys to happiness, physical education, teamwork, learning about the importance of good hygiene and physical health, Jigsaw and UNCRF.

Science & Technology – Looking at floating and sinking, sea temperatures, how fish breath underwater, research, doodle learning, creating digital pieces of work, such as power points, continuing to access hwb, Jit and seesaw.

Expressive Arts – Cooking and opportunities to work with food, creating and singing songs for the topic, topic related art, creating art using a range of resources, tools and materials, developing their creativity by giving them opportunities to paint, colour, build and draw, linked to the topics and key dates.

RE – Deeper understanding of Christianity and stories from the Bible.

- Reading with them as often as possible to support them and ask questions to develop their comprehension skills.
- Providing opportunities related to our topic, such as: Taking them to the beach or relevant Museum exhibits.

- Practise weekly spellings with your child please!

- Any recycling would be very handy for our junk modelling.

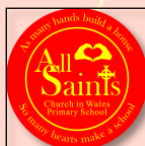
