Welcome Back

It has been lovely to welcome everyone back to school after the summer holiday and I hope that you all have had an enjoyable break. In the afternoon, the gates will be open between 3:20pm to 3:45pm, with the children being dismissed at **3:30pm**.

Administration of Medicines.

The administering of medicine to a child is the responsibility of the parent / carer. If the parent/ carer is unavailable during the day, then a medical form must be completed, giving permission for a member of the office staff to administer the medicine. All medicines must be handed directly to the school office by a parent or carer in the original container and should not be decanted into another container.

Medicines MUST NOT be kept by the pupil. The medicine must clearly state the child's name, and the exact dosages and timing required as well as the name of the medicine. Should the dosage of the medicine change, a new permission form will be required.

Uniform / PE Uniform

The turnout of school uniform at the start of this new academic year has been excellent. Could you please ensure that your child's name is written clearly on their uniform, PE Kit, bags, water bottles & lunchboxes to assist with identification.

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Health & Wellbeing Sessions

Your child will participate in Health & Wellbeing sessions each week. These sessions will include play activities, games and sports, alongside lessons that help children learn how to care for their physical and mental health.

Please see the table below for the days on which these sessions will take place and whether your child is required to wear their P.E. uniform.

The P.E. uniform consists of:

- Black shorts or a black skirt
- Black joggers or black leggings
- A house-colour T-shirt
- An optional red long-sleeved overtop



The uniform is available from [A Class Apart](#). However, purchasing from A Class Apart is not compulsory, as suitable items can also be bought from a variety of other shops and supermarkets.

For safety reasons, all pupils must wear the correct P.E. clothing and suitable, securely fitting sports trainers. Clothing or footwear that is inappropriate for physical activity—including jeans, skirts, dresses, sandals, sliders, Crocs or boots—must not be worn, as it may restrict movement or create a risk of injury. Pupils may be unable to participate in the session if their clothing or footwear is considered unsuitable on safety grounds.

We also strongly request that pupils do not wear expensive or treasured professional sports-team kits—including football, rugby or other replica kits—for P.E. sessions. These may become muddy, soiled or damaged during indoor or outdoor activities, and the school cannot accept responsibility for this.

Thank you for helping us ensure that every child is dressed safely, comfortably and appropriately so that they can participate fully in their Health & Wellbeing sessions.
