Our work this term will include...

Mathematics & Numeracy -Colour-brown and orange, shape-circles and triangles, sorting/matching, counting, number, capacity.

- Languages, Literacy & Communication -listening to stories linked to Autumn, Christmas and our theme of Hunaniaeth/Identity, recognising and writing our names, tracing, nursery rhymes, sound recognition.
- Humanities -naming body parts, hygiene and senses and our topic of Hunaniaeth/Identity,

How you can help your child at home...

- Label all their belongings, including their shoes to promote independence and help look after their belongings.
- Enjoy reading stories together and discussing their contents.
- Discuss, label and share feelings and emotions.
- Encourage your child to hold a pencil correctly, when they show signs of being ready.
- Provide mark making opportunities.
- Play number and counting games together.
- Talk about the sounds that letters make, we will explore alphabet names later on.
- Encourage independence in personal care: putting coats on, carrying belongings etc.
- Enjoy puzzles and jigsaws.
- Begin to recognise their name written down.
- Sing Nursery rhymes and action songs together.
