How you can help your child at home...

- Read regularly together to build confidence, vocabulary and comprehension.
- Talk about our topic: Identity - discuss what makes us who we are (family, culture, hobbies, communities).
- Chat about age-appropriate current news to build curiosity and understanding.
- Practise times tables little and often using quick-fire questions, games or Doodle Tables.
- Use Doodle (Maths, English, Tables & Spellings) for short, regular sessions throughout the week.
- Try quick mental-maths moments (number bonds, doubles, halves, quick addition/subtraction) and practise telling the time.
- Support weekly spellings sent home on a Monday.
- Talk openly about feelings to help children name emotions and build resilience.
