Our work this term will include...

- *Mathematics & Numeracy* – Place Value to 1,000,000, addition and subtraction using formal methods, mental methods and manipulatives. Statistics-pie charts, frequency tables and finding the mean. Multiplication and division, factors, multiples, prime numbers. Algebra. Fractions – equivalent, simplifying, adding and subtracting, fractions of an amount. Ratio and Proportion.
- *Languages, Literacy & Communication* – Persuasive writing- facts and opinions, using logical connectives, reasoned arguments, rhetorical questions, emotive language and persuasive techniques. Understanding representation in media and creating an inclusive media. Comprehension skills. Discussion – balanced arguments, sourcing evidence, giving reasons and justifying. Welsh – using Welsh phrases in everyday situation.
- *Humanities* – similarities and differences between people's lives. Recognise how different factors can impact people and communities. Exploring identity and impact on diversity and society. How my life is different or similar to others. Understand how my community is represented. Human rights and equality and understanding peoples' rights.
- *Health & Wellbeing* –Jigsaw, Anti-bullying week, British Food Fortnight and learning about food miles, Road Safety week. Looking after the environment. Gymnastics, dance, ball skills.
- *Science & Technology* – our identity – fingerprints and DNA. Using AI to generate images. Research linked to our top. Presenting information using a variety of digital platforms. Online science and technology sessions. Micro bit workshops.
- *Expressive Arts*- Finger print art. Creating a Nativity inspired stained glass window.
- *RVE* – Understanding Christianity – Kingdom of God and People of God. Podcasts – interviewing characters from the Nativity.
