Help with School Costs: School Essentials Grant

Parents and carers – did you know there's support available to help with the cost of school essentials like uniform, equipment, sports kit and more? The School Essentials Grant from the Welsh Government offers financial help to families on lower incomes who qualify for certain benefits.

Here are the key points:

The grant gives £125 per child for learners in Reception through Year 11. For children entering Year 7, the grant is £200 to reflect the extra costs of starting secondary school.

It's available once per child, per school year. If you think you might qualify, you can check details and apply via the Welsh Government website: [School Essentials Grant](#). If you need help with the application, please contact the school office—we're here to support.
