Tinned Fruit, UHT Milk and Cereal.



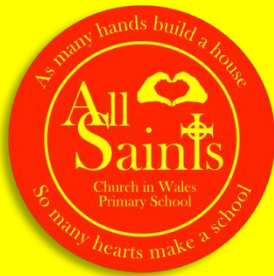
If you would like to donate and support the foodbank, please bring in your food donations on the morning of **Thursday 16th October** and place them safely in the designated area on the school playground.

We are delighted to announce another All Saints Primary School Night Out at a Cardiff Devils game – a fantastic family event for our school community! This year, we will be attending the Cardiff Devils' home match against the Glasgow Clan on Sunday 7th December. The game begins at 5:00pm and lasts no longer than 2½ hours. Even more excitingly, this match is the Cardiff Devils' annual "Air the Bear" game. At the first Devils goal, fans throw teddy bears onto the ice, creating an incredible sight as hundreds of cuddly toys rain down. All bears are then collected and donated to children's hospitals and charities across South Wales. Every Christmas, the Devils players personally deliver these teddy bears to children in hospital, spending time with them and spreading festive cheer. If you would like to take part, please bring along a new teddy bear wrapped in a clear bag or cellophane to ensure it stays clean and safe for donation. This promises to be a special evening full of fun, excitement, and community spirit – we'd love for as many families as possible to join us!

The discounted ticket costs are follows:

Adult £ 21 Child £ 12 (under 3s are free as long as they sit on an adult's lap)
Seniors (60+) £ 19 Youth (16-21) £ 15

This thrilling event is open to any members of your child's family e.g. parents, carers, siblings, grandparents, cousins etc and isn't limited to a maximum number, so bring everyone along.
