Restart a Heart Day — Thank you, Donna & St John Ambulance!

Yesterday our pupils took part in Restart a Heart Day, working with Donna from St John Ambulance to learn— in an age-appropriate, child-friendly way — what to do if someone collapses: check for danger, call 999, start chest compressions, and get an adult to fetch a defibrillator. The session helped build confidence that *everyone* can help in an emergency, which is exactly what this UK-wide campaign is all about: raising awareness of cardiac arrest and giving people practical CPR skills. A timely reminder: our school has its own defibrillator (AED) on site, purchased thanks to fundraising led by Mr Ashworth. It's registered on The Circuit — the national defibrillator network — so ambulance services can direct bystanders to it quickly if ever needed. We're proud of how calmly and sensibly the children engaged with this lifesaving learning—and grateful to Donna for a brilliant, reassuring workshop.
