Whether you love numbers or feel a bit rusty, you're very welcome. It's friendly and informal—drop in for the hour if you can—and part of our commitment to involve parents and carers in school life and celebrate the fantastic maths happening in our classrooms. We'd love a great turnout!

Next week is Anti-Bullying Week and we're kicking off with **Odd Socks Day on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November** to celebrate individuality and kindness.
