The Vale of Glamorgan Council is updating its Active Travel Network Map (ATNM) and would love to hear from the community. The aim is to make walking, wheeling and cycling the most natural way to do local journeys—improving health, wellbeing, and the liveability of our towns and villages. As part of the review (required by the Active Travel (Wales) Act 2013), the map will show:

Existing routes that already meet Welsh Government standards, and
Future routes that are proposed or need upgrades to meet those standards.

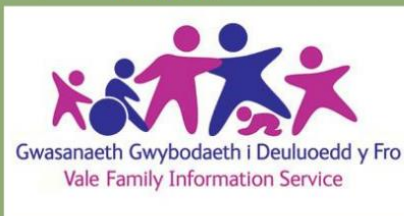
