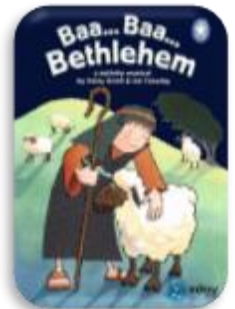

Black shorts/skort or black joggers/black leggings

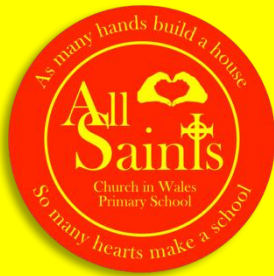
Optional long-sleeve red over-top for warmth
