All Saints is a wonderfully special place at Christmas, and this half term has been a joyful reminder of our shared purpose to help every child flourish—living out our values of being respectful, being ready and being responsible. Thank you for the warmth, generosity and prayerful support you continue to show our school family.

The children have enjoyed a rich sweep of authentic learning experiences: Year 1 & Year 2 explored nature and seasonal change at Porthkerry Park; Year 3 investigated coastlines at Porthcawl Beach; Year 4 stretched their scientific curiosity at Techniquest; Year 5 deepened local-history knowledge at the Barry War Museum; and Year 6 laced up for Cardiff Winter Wonderland ice skating—courage, balance and plenty of laughter! Our Nursery children loved their visit to Fonmon Castle, and Year 2 completed Kerbcraft, building safe-travel habits for life.

We also hosted the CSC National NQT Professional Learning Programme here at All Saints, and welcomed PC Dan Taylor to work with Year 6 on cyber safety. Families joined Gemma from CookStars for an adults-only cooking session, and our faith leaders pupil voice group helped us mark a reflective Faith/Christmas Day—a moment to give thanks for God's provision and consider how we can serve others. Service and remembrance remained at the heart of our community life as Year 5 & Year 6 contributed to the All Saints Church Remembrance Service, and our School Ambassadors represented the school at the Royal British Legion Schools Remembrance Service and Cross-Laying Ceremony with dignity and compassion. As a whole school we took part in the Into Film Festival, Odd Socks Day and Anti-Bullying Week, wore spots for Children in Need, pulled on festive knits for Christmas Jumper Day, and thoroughly enjoyed our Christmas lunch! We had a brilliant PTA Christmas Fair, a joyous Landing Afternoon for families, and every class enjoyed Take Off Days to spark January's learning. Festive fun abounded—Christmas parties, Toy Day, a visit from Aladdin for a whole-school pantomime. Most of all, we are so proud of how beautifully the children shared the Christmas story in their concerts—their singing, speaking and smiles filled our hearts. Da iawn pawb.

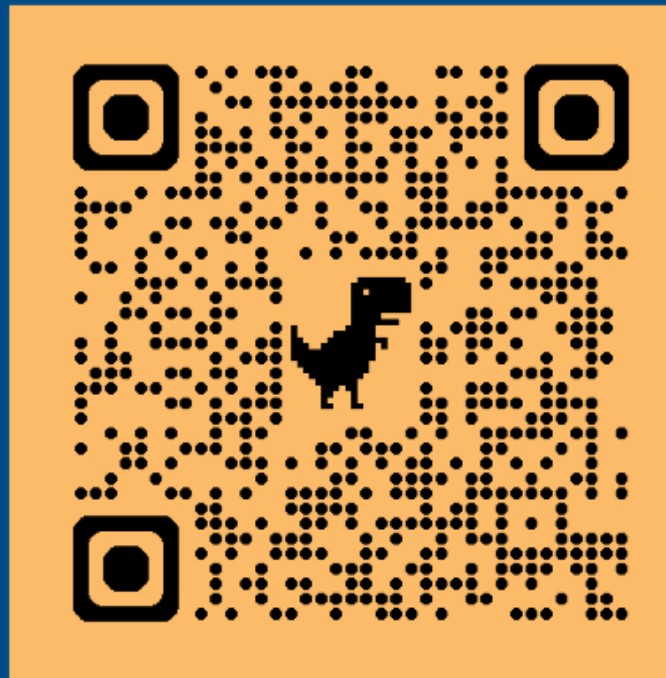

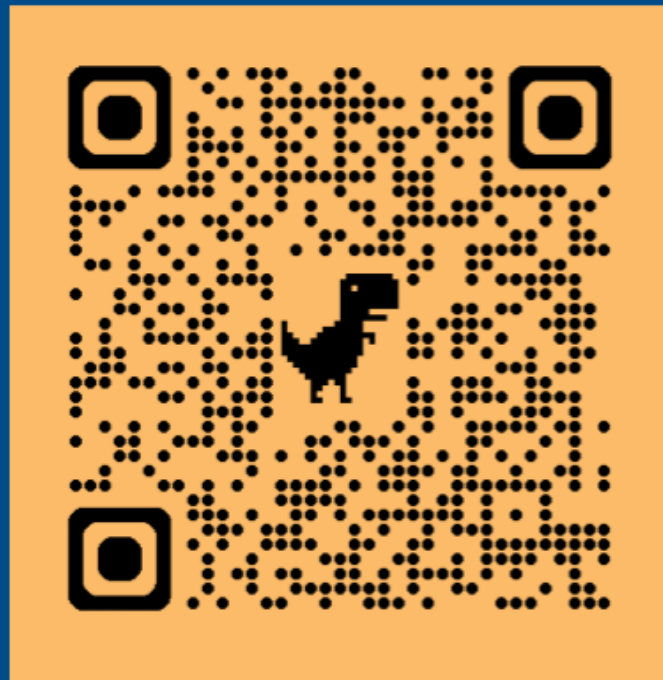
