Our work this term will include...



- Mathematics & Numeracy -Colours-gold and red, yellow and green. Shapes-squares and rectangles. Sorting/matching. Counting. Number. Capacity. Pattern. Time.
- Languages, Literacy & Communication -listening to Winter and Spring stories. Recognising and writing names. Tracing. Nursery rhymes. Sound recognition. Welsh greetings, counting, singing, weather, colours and feelings.
