Our work this term will include...



Mathematics & Numeracy – Number recognition and formation to 10 and beyond, mass and capacity , ED shapes, length, height and time.

Languages, Literacy & Communication –Monster Phonics, pencil control and letter formation, name recognition and writing, story links to topic and Winter.

Humanities –Exploring the seasons, animals from different countries, Luna New Year. The Big Bird Watch.

Health & Wellbeing – Self registration of feelings, discussing how we can feel many different emotions, following class rules, the importance of proper hygiene, developing motor skills through provisions and physical education. Caring for the environment and animals

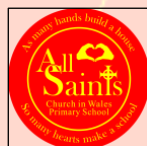
