Our work this term will include...

Mathematics & Numeracy – We will be developing our understanding of multiplication and division, as well as exploring measuring and temperature. We will also take part in a range of problem-solving and numerical reasoning activities.

Languages, Literacy & Communication – We will be exploring the genre of information texts and creating fact files about a chosen sea creature or animal. Learners will also study recount writing and develop their skills by planning and writing newspaper articles. In Welsh, we will focus on the questions Beth wyt ti'n wisgo? and Pam? Ga i...?, building confidence in speaking and responding in simple conversations.

Humanities – Our topic this term is *Water*. We will be learning about the five oceans, the layers of the ocean, and how water is transported around the world. Learners will investigate geographical features and develop their understanding of how water shapes our planet.

Health & Wellbeing – In PE, we will be developing teamwork and physical skills through Netball in Spring 1 and Football in Spring 2. We will also explore diversity and inclusion, as well as what makes a healthy, balanced diet.

Science & Technology – We will investigate states of water, the water cycle, and how humans use and move water. Learners will also develop their digital skills through research, simple data handling, and presenting information linked to our topic.

Expressive Arts - Every Monday, learners will take part in music lessons with Mrs Venter, exploring dynamics, instrument families, pitch, rhythm and Welsh music. They will also create artwork inspired by ocean colours and textures and respond creatively to our water theme. Our creative work will link closely to our water topic, including experimenting with colour, texture and movement to represent oceans and waves.

RE – In Spring 1, we will be learning about Judaism, focusing on special books and places of worship, and exploring why the Torah is so important to Jewish people. In Spring 2, we will be learning about Salvation and thinking about why Christians call the day Jesus died “Good Friday”.

Our school values this term are Perseverance and Forgiveness, and our Action for Happiness Keys are Direction & Resilience

How you can help your child at home...

Read regularly together to build confidence, vocabulary and comprehension. Ask simple questions about the story and talk about any new words you come across.

Talk about our topic: Water — discuss where we see water in everyday life (weather, oceans, rivers, puddles, the water cycle) to help make real-life links.

Chat about age-appropriate current news to develop curiosity, understanding and language skills.

Practise times tables little and often, using quick-fire questions, games or Doodle Tables to build fluency.

Use Doodle (Maths, English, Tables & Spellings) for short, regular sessions throughout the week.

Try quick mental-maths moments during daily routines (number bonds, doubles, halves, quick addition/subtraction) and **practise telling the time** using both analogue and digital clocks.

Support weekly spellings, sent home on a Monday.

Talk openly about feelings to help children name emotions and develop resilience and wellbeing.

- Please ensure children bring nut free snacks to school.

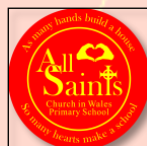
