Mathematics & Numeracy – Interpreting Charts, Division, Temperature, Statistics, Fractions, Algebra, Decimals.

Languages, Literacy & Communication – Instructional Writing, inference, explanation and comparison, Recounts, Persuasive writing, applying grammar in context, Group discussions, explaining ideas and opinions, retelling stories, Presenting information, Drama and role play.

Humanities – Locate natural disasters on maps and globes, identify continents, countries and oceans affected, understand why disasters happen in certain places, Learn about earthquakes, volcanoes, floods, storms, wildfires.

Health & Wellbeing – Understanding what it means to be healthy, Recognising healthy food choices and balanced diet, Understanding exercise and fitness, How sleep and rest affect health Hygiene and taking care of your body.

Science & Technology – Structure of the Earth, Tectonic plates and earthquakes, Volcanoes and eruptions, Forces involved in natural disasters (wind, water, gravity), How floods and landslides happen, Strength and direction of forces, Properties of materials used in buildings, Which materials are strong, flexible or waterproof, How materials can reduce damage, Testing materials for strength and suitability.

Expressive Arts - Explore how artists show power and movement, Use colour, texture and line to show natural forces, create artwork inspired by storms, volcanoes and waves.

RE– Islam - Special books and places of worship. Why is the Quran so important to Islamic people? Salvation- Why do Christians call the day Jesus died “Good Friday”?

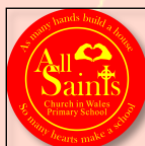
