Following our decision to leave X (formerly Twitter), the school has explored safe and appropriate ways to continue sharing news and celebrations with our community.

We are pleased to announce that All Saints will launch an official Instagram account on Tuesday 10th February, to coincide with Safer Internet Day.

The account will be private, meaning users will need to request to follow and be approved by the school. It will be used to share photos and posts from special events and celebrations, such as Red Nose Day and whole-school activities, allowing families to see some of the wonderful learning experiences at All Saints. Staff will not post daily updates but will share key moments and events.

Before the account goes live, we kindly ask all parents and carers to check and update their child's social media permissions via Arbor. If you have any difficulties accessing Arbor, please contact the school office so we can amend our records.
