ECHO & School Ambassadors at Porthkerry Park — Pupil Voice in Action

This week, our ECHO (Every Child Has Opportunities) group and School Ambassadors took part in a special workshop at Porthkerry Country Park to help co-design a brand-new woodland activity trail.

After road-testing some of the park's family challenges, the children met in the Lodge to share the results of a whole-school vote and pitch their own ideas for six activity posts that will encourage movement, curiosity and nature-spotting along the route.

What made us especially proud was the pupils' focus on inclusion and access for everyone. They asked how families of all ages and abilities could enjoy the trail, and suggested ways to blend technology with nature— for example, scannable QR codes, audio prompts in multiple languages, and clear visual/tactile cues such as braille and posts at different heights. Their thinking linked strongly to our work on equality and showed real empathy for the diverse users of a public space.

We're grateful to Matthew Lory (Woodland Project Officer, Vale of Glamorgan Council) for inviting our children to be part of the design process, and to Rebecca and Emma from 35percent for leading an inspiring, hands-on session. The design team will now refine the children's recommendations and create the final posts and instructions.

When the trail opens later this year, our pupils will be invited back to test it for real. The legacy will be far-reaching: pride and ownership for the children involved, new memories for All Saints families, and a richer, more welcoming Porthkerry Country Park for the Barry community and visitors from further afield.

Our Llais y Ddraig (Voice of the Dragon) Welsh Pupil Voice Group, are working hard to encourage everyone to use Welsh as much as possible in school. We are working tirelessly towards our goal of achieving the Silver Award here at our brilliant school.

Please encourage your children to use and speak Welsh as much as possible.

Financial Wellbeing Support for Unpaid Carers

We want to share information about a Financial Wellbeing Service offering direct grants for unpaid carers who are caring for someone living in Cardiff or the Vale of Glamorgan. These grants are designed as a hardship fund and can help with practical everyday needs, including supermarket vouchers, household items and technology support. The vouchers can be used in a range of stores such as Argos, Asda, Currys, Iceland and Tesco.

To apply, carers simply scan the QR code for their area and complete a short application form. A professional will be needed to verify the caring role. If support is needed with the application, families can contact the Financial Wellbeing Service directly via the email address on the poster.
