As always, our focus remains on ensuring the children are happy, confident and thriving in school — and this half term has been packed with exciting opportunities and memorable experiences.

The children have enjoyed a wonderful range of learning beyond the classroom. Year 2 visited Cardiff Castle to meet Jay the Knight and take part in a knight workshop, Reception explored Cwm Talwg Woods, and a group of pupils visited Porthkerry Park to contribute to an important community project. Our Year 6 pupils have taken part in Cardiff Rugby sessions and swimming lessons, while Reception welcomed the Size of Wales workshop. We were also delighted to host Jenner Park pupils as part of our joint pupil voice work, strengthening friendships and collaboration between our schools.

Across the whole school we launched our new Monster Phonics and Superhero Spellings programme with great excitement, enjoyed the spectacular whole-school performance of *Creature Chronicles*, and marked Safer Internet Day with important learning about online safety. Alongside the children's learning, it has been fantastic to see so many families engaging with our parent and carer opportunities — from the "Understanding Our Emotions" family learning workshops and sewing sessions, to Cook Stars in the Learning Lounge and the full-day First Aid course. We were also pleased to welcome Jenny Lambert into school to work creatively with our Year 5 and 6 pupils and families.
