Fizz, Fun and Future Scientists at Dow

As part of British Science Week 2026, a group of our pupils from Years 4, 5 and 6 enjoyed an exciting visit to Dow Silicones, where they took part in a hands-on chemistry workshop. The session was led by Dr Gareth Francis from Working Science and gave pupils a fantastic opportunity to explore real-world science in a fun and engaging way.



During the workshop, pupils created their own bath bombs and bubble bath products, mixing ingredients, observing chemical reactions and choosing their own scents. The activities brought science to life, helping children to understand how chemistry is used in everyday products while developing their problem-solving skills, creativity and scientific thinking.



The visit was a truly memorable experience, with pupils returning to school full of excitement and eager to share what they had learned. It was wonderful to see their curiosity and enthusiasm for science grow, with many inspired to think about future careers in STEM.
