#### **Our work this term will include...**

- *Mathematics & Numeracy* – Fractions Decimals and Percentages. Ratio and Proportion. Probability. Algebra. Time
- *Languages, Literacy & Communication* writing and adapting scripts and short scenes. Create, perform, respond and reflect through drama; and understand how performance works and improve it over time. Learn about the processes involved in devising, rehearsing, refining and presenting drama and film. Writing non-chronological reports. Analyse theatre performance of Matilda and compare this to the film and book. Superhero Spelling. Welsh – using Welsh phrases in everyday situations.
- *Humanities* – studying stereotyping in films and adverts. Learning about the history of film and theatre and making comparisons between films from the past and modern times. Learning about the pace of the developments in movie and animation technologies.
- *Health & Wellbeing* – Jigsaw. Outdoor games. Transition activities.
- *Science & Technology* – Creating I movies and adverts, improving editing skills and creating sound effects. Using animation apps and software.
- *Expressive Arts*– music from films and theatre, animations. Performing arts. The use of Foley artistry.
- *RVE* – The Gospel and inspirational people of faith.
