Our work this term will include...

- Mathematics & Numeracy – Money, Time, Length and Perimeter, Decimals, Algebra, Converting Units, Statistics, 2D and 3D Shapes, Probability, Position and Direction, Mass Volume and Capacity.
- Languages, Literacy & Communication – Instructional Writing, inference, explanation and comparison, Recounts, Persuasive writing, applying grammar in context, Group discussions, explaining ideas and opinions, retelling stories, Presenting information, Drama and role play.
- Humanities – Exploring how daily habits (exercise, diet, rest) affect quality of life, Recognising how lifestyles can differ between people and communities, Considering how knowledge about health has changed over time, Developing informed views about what it means to live a healthy life.
- Health & Wellbeing – Understanding how exercise affects the body, recognising the importance of physical activity for health, exploring how exercise supports heart, lungs and muscles, understanding links between exercise and mental wellbeing, developing awareness of healthy lifestyle choices, considering how exercise can support long-term health
- Science & Technology – Understanding how the heart and lungs respond to exercise, exploring how muscles work during physical activity, recognising how the body needs oxygen during exercise, investigating changes in heart rate and breathing, understanding cause and effect in the body during exercise, developing skills in observing and recording results
- Expressive Arts – Creating a visual poster to communicate ideas, using drawing and design to present information, expressing ideas about health through images and colour, developing creativity in layout and presentation, using visual elements to engage an audience
- RVE – Reflecting on personal choices about health and wellbeing, considering what it means to live a healthy and balanced life.
