- Mathematics & Numeracy – Addition, subtraction, rotating shapes, compose shapes, decompose shapes, sharing, grouping, even and odd numbers, doubling, patterns, describe positioning, explore mapping, representing maps, creating maps, data Handling
- Languages, Literacy & Communication – Monster Phonics, CVC words, creative writing, instructional writing, rhyming, basic punctuation, stories and writing based on topic.

How you can help your child at home...

- Support your child with their handwriting but allow them to write independently.
- Support them in learning to write their name with correct pencil grip using capital and lowercase letters and the correct letter formation.
- Play number games, write and read numbers and letters in different medium e.g., shaving foam, sand, glitter, playdough, chalk, using the correct number formation.
- Read stories together and encourage them to talk about them. (e.g., How do you think the character felt? What part did you enjoy the most and why?)
- Talk to them about Summer and the changes in season.
- Talk about or provide experiences relating to our topic (Out and About-Transport and The Beach)
- Try to provide your child with opportunities to speak to you in Welsh e.g., Counting to 10, different colours, naming body parts, can I (Ga i...), What do you want? (Beth wyt ti eisiau?), saying thank you/diolch Continue to help them to develop independence with personal hygiene e.g. going to the toilet independently, flushing the toilet and washing hands with soap, blowing own nose.
- Help children develop independence in putting their coats on, doing up buttons and zips and fastening their shoes.
