## Supporting Children to Stay Safe and Smart Online

In recent weeks, the news has once again highlighted the growing concerns surrounding children's use of social media, online content and the influence of technology on young people's wellbeing. At All Saints, we recognise that keeping children safe extends far beyond the school gates, and we remain committed to working closely with families to help our pupils navigate the digital world safely, responsibly and with confidence. As part of this commitment, we are delighted to be welcoming Dr Sangeet Bhullar, Executive Director of WISE KIDS, to school on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July to deliver a series of sessions for Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 pupils, helping them to become not just safe online, but digitally smart. The sessions will explore topics including social media, AI, online behaviour, peer pressure, misinformation and digital wellbeing, empowering children to make positive choices and seek help when needed.

We would particularly encourage parents and carers to attend the FREE WISE KIDS Parent and Carers Workshop, which will take place from 3:00pm to 4:00pm. This supportive and practical session will provide valuable advice on parental controls, setting boundaries, positive role modelling and understanding the online world our children are growing up in. Recognising that childcare can often be a barrier to attendance, Miss Allen has kindly organised a supervised crèche-style provision for children whose parents and carers are attending the workshop, ensuring that as many families as possible are able to benefit from this important session.

Places can be reserved by scanning the QR code or by completing the online form. We are incredibly grateful to Dr Bhullar and WISE KIDS for supporting our school community in this way. By working together, we can continue to ensure that our children are equipped to be Ready, Respectful and Responsible citizens, both in the real world and online.
